W.I. TUCKER TROPHY 6th & 7th JULY 2019

CONDITIONS:

1. The Whitchurch Silver Dragon and the Golynos Oak shall each be decided by aggregate over 36 holes. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be decided on the lowest score for the last 18 holes of each event (or 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes). If a tie still arises, the scores for the first round shall be treated in the same way until resolved.
2. The W.I. Tucker Trophy shall be decided by the aggregate score of the Whitchurch Silver Dragon and the Golynos Oak. In the event of a tie, the title shall be shared.
3. Any player not present at the teeing ground when called to start shall incur the penalties outlined in Rule 5-3a
4. The Championship Committee reserves the right to fix and / or alter starting times. Start times for the Golynos Oak will be in reverse order to the finishing scores in the Whitchurch Silver Dragon.
5. It will be obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A list of conforming golf balls.
6. A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his performance. In this respect, the attention of competitors is drawn to the prescribed list of drugs issued by the Sports Council. Any competitor infringing this condition or who refuses a request to take a test may be disqualified.
7. Withdrawals:
 - a) If a player withdraws from an event, whether before or after the closure of entries, their withdrawal is final, and re-entry will not be allowed.
 - b) Any player who:
 - (i) Withdraws from an event after the draw has been published, or,
 - (ii) Fails to appear on the tee at their appointed start time,Must, without delay, furnish the Championship Committee with a satisfactory explanation, confirmed in writing. If they do not do so, they may be barred from entering or playing in the W.I. Tucker Trophy for such period as the Championship Committee may decide. Furthermore, the player in question will forfeit their entrance fee.
8. Any competitor not conforming to the Dress Code of either Whitchurch (Cardiff) GC or Newport GC will not be allowed on the course.
9. If the Championship Committee, consider that a player is guilty of a serious breach of misconduct it may impose a penalty of disqualification (Rule 1-2 & as per the Wales Golf Code of Conduct).

ENTRIES:

10. Entries shall be made only on the Special Entry Form obtainable through Whitchurch (Cardiff) Golf Club website, Wales Golf website or Home Club Secretaries.
11. Entries will be limited to 66 competitors in total, with a maximum of 6 places which are reserved for each of the host Clubs. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entries from the highest handicap competitors shall be decided by ballot, which shall take place immediately after the closing date for entries. All unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay thereafter but will be given the opportunity to compete if scratching subsequently occurs. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not compete.
12. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status and shall sign the declaration to that effect contained in the entry form.
13. Entries will only be accepted from those whose handicaps do not exceed THREE STROKES under the Council of National Golf Unions' current handicapping scheme.
14. The exact handicap certified at the date of entry will be used for all purposes. Subsequent changes will not be taken into account.
15. Competitors must enter through the Secretary of their Home Club who is to sign the declaration in the entry form.
16. All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Championship Committee which reserves the right to accept or refuse, or having accepted, subsequently rejects any entry without giving a reason for its decision.
17. The entrance fee of £35 payable to "Whitchurch (Cardiff) Golf Club" together with fully completed entry form & SAE must be received by the General Manager, Whitchurch (Cardiff) Golf Club by noon on Friday, 21st June 2019.
18. Entries will not be accepted by telephone or email. Entrance fees will not be refunded unless notification of scratching is received before the closing date for entries.
19. The Championship Committee reserves the right to disqualify any competitor making a false statement on his entry form.

PRIZES:

20. Prizes for both the Golynos Oak and the Whitchurch Silver Dragon will be:

1 st - £200 voucher	2 nd - £100 voucher	3 rd - £50 voucher
Best Gross am - £25 voucher	Best Gross pm - £25 voucher	
21. No competitor may win more than one prize at each event.
22. There are no prize vouchers for the W.I. Tucker Trophy for which there is no entrance fee. A replica will be awarded by the Wales Golf.
23. Order of Merit points will be based on the 72-hole gross score.

The presentation of prizes for the Golynos Oak, Whitchurch Silver Dragon and the W.I. Tucker Trophy will take place in the Clubhouse of Newport Golf Club immediately following play on Sunday 7th July 2019
